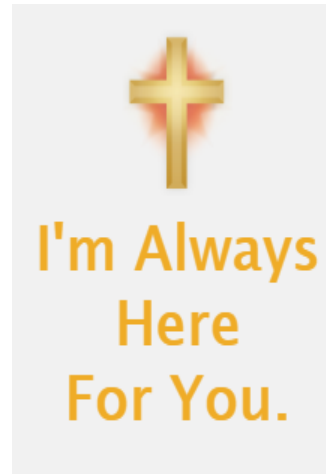


Sacred Heart Parish - Meeting the Challenges Brought About By The Coronavirus

You probably are aware by now that Archbishop Nelson J. Pérez announced the **suspension of all public Masses** in the Archdiocese of Philadelphia effective today, March 18, at Noon, and until further notice.

Though public Masses are suspended in all churches in the Archdiocese, I promise that I will be as attentive as possible to all the spiritual, pastoral, and charitable needs of the people of this parish.

Private prayer will still be available in our Perpetual Adoration Chapel 24/7.

The praying of the Stations of the Cross has been suspended.

Baptisms, Marriages, and Funerals will take place as usual but with due regard for the limitation of participants and reasonable social distancing.

Confessions will be heard by appointment for those who are in dire need of this beautiful Sacrament of Forgiveness. Please phone the office to make an appointment - 610-948-5915. Also, those who are in imminent danger of dying will be given the Sacrament.

The parish office will be closed.
